Raised in Thailand and Uganda my appetite for musical adventures takes me all over the globe, exploring and redefining divergent traditions. I am always on the lookout for vibrant collaborations with unique voices in music, far from conventional, hitting the essence and celebrate life.

I define myself as an improviser. This is essentially what I do, it keeps me ticking and in combination with my unique instrument, artistry and fantasy is my true power and provides me with an inspiring and rewarding life.

I want my music to be of uncompromising quality and have a way of in music to do not the obvious, to do it different.

As an improviser and composer I own a language that combines aesthetics and techniques of contemporary classical music with the virility of jazz. I do transport my horn into areas of contemporary music and blur the limit between traditional and experimental sounds, giving my instrument dimension and depth. I do cherish real-time sound production, using complex extended flute techniques and electronic effects and love to casually shatter any stereotypes around the flute.

I am a mediator between various musicians, ensembles and creators, and creator of special themes, projects, repertoire and experimental concert forms. I bridge the gap between the performing artist and the audience, sometimes with a social statement.

I hold up an international touring career and particularly gained much international acclaim for my solo recitals, contemporary cinematic jazz, next to my interpretations of Afro-Cuban religious folklore, West African Fula music or my collaborations with Turkish free improvised kinds of music.

Genre-bending collaborations is spanning an arc of collaborations theater, performance art, visual arts, film and dance.

Maintaining a heavy schedule in multiple capacities as soloist, composer, producer, bandleader, teacher and curator. Seeking to capitalize on the music-hungry fanbase in the Utrecht area, I launched festivals and concert series, serving the community through the arts. I am passionately committed to music education and outreach, having given masterclasses all around the world.

Obsessed by music I use my voice to reach a world beyond. I surrender completely to artistic expression
